






## 2025 Membership by Member Type

**Non-Physician:** allied health professionals, nurses, pharmacists, medical technologists, respiratory therapists, OR and SPD techs, public health epidemiologists, clinical microbiologists, environmental health & safety specialists.

**Senior:** Active members who reach 65 years of age or who no longer derive income from their practice will become Senior Members.

**International:** This membership type is available to individuals residing outside the United States.
